Re-enrollment

Summer is coming up quickly and we are starting to make exciting plans for our summer program. It is very important that you take a moment to fill out the re-enrollment forms. This will guarantee that your child will have a spot for summer and fall. There is a re-enrollment fee of \$75.00 for children that are continuing on into the next school year. Also there is a summer fee for 2 years and up of \$140.00 for full time students, three day a week students are \$90.00, and two day a week students are \$70.00. This will be to help cover the cost for all the fun-filled events that we will have. Summer fee will be on your June statement. If you will be leaving for the summer and returning for fall you will need to put a deposit down to hold your spot. The deposit will go toward your fall tuition. Full time families will be charged \$250 and part

time families will be charged \$150. The re-enrollment forms are due back by February 28th. We will open enrollment to the public on the 28th. Please stop by the office if you have any questions.
