
### Father's Day Breakfast

### Pick Up and Drop off Times

Please remember to pick up your child on time. The school closes by 6pm. That means every child should be signed out and ready to go at 6pm. Anyone late picking up his or her child will be charged an initial fee of \$15, and \$15 will be charged for each 15-minute increment or portion thereof. Late pick-up charges will also apply for sessions that end at 12pm, 1pm, and 3pm.

Also, please do not drop off before your scheduled time. We staff the school according to the children scheduled to be present, and when you come early, we run the risk of being



out of ratio. If you do come early, please stay with your child until your designated time.

### Extra Clothes

Please remember to always have a set of extra clothes including shoes, socks, and underwear. We will be playing in water all summer, plus you never know when a spill or a potty accident may happen.

### Rainbow Room




The month of July will be filled with more fun summer activities. Please continue to apply sunscreen in the morning and check the calendar for summer activities.
